

#### **ARRÁBIDA & SESIMBRA WINE TOUR**

Discover the secrets of these hills overlooking the sea

After crossing the 25th of April Bridge, the first stop will be at Sesimbra Castle, where you can enjoy the panoramic views overlooking this shermen's village, famous for its beaches and fish and seafood restaurants. Later in Azeitão, we ell visit one of the oldest and most important wine cellars in Portugal (Caves José Maria da Fonseca) and taste Setúbal traditional Moscatel. A tour with a panoramic view of the beautiful Arrábida Mountains and a stop in Setúbal to explore the city centre. Return to Lisbon on Europe's longest bridge: the Vasco da Gama Bridge.
